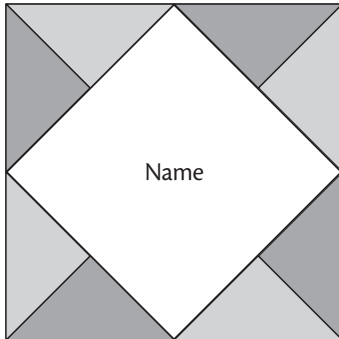
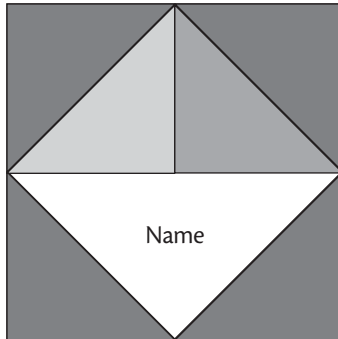


Signature Blocks

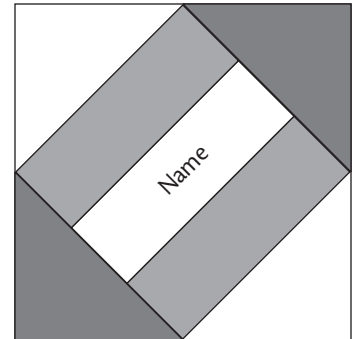
(for 6 × 6 inch blocks)



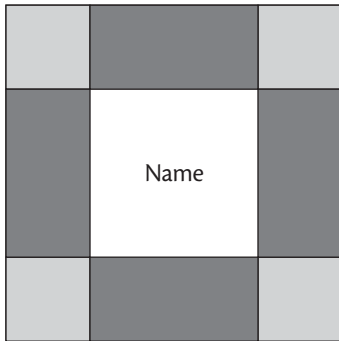
1. Traditional: Found in many antique signature quilts. 8 small triangles surround 1 large center square. Start by measuring the corners of the center square in the center of the sides.



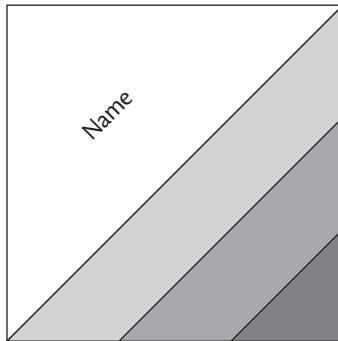
2. Variation on Traditional: Center square divided into 3 triangles, with only 4 surrounding triangles. Start by measuring the corners of the center square in the center of the sides.



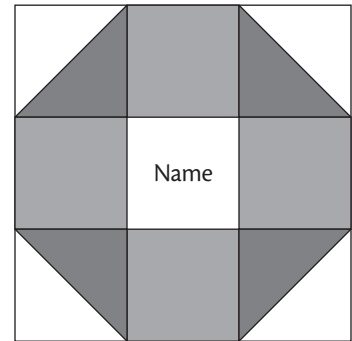
3. Cracker: Center square made up of 3 equal rectangles, with 4 surrounding triangles. Start by measuring the corners of the center square in the center of the sides.



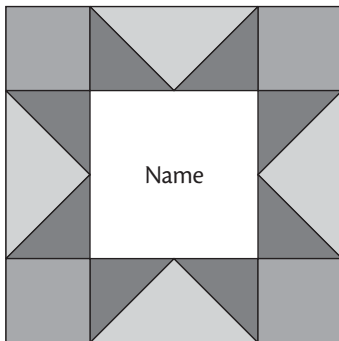
4. Puss in the Corner: 4 small 1½ inch squares in the corners, with a square in the center and 4 surrounding rectangles.



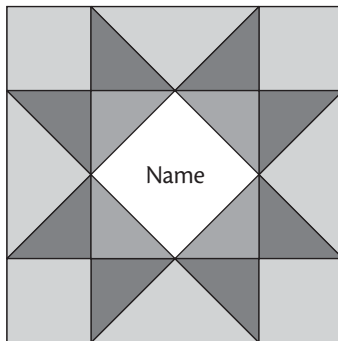
5. Roman Stripe: 2 triangles with stripes across the bottom, right triangle. Divide square in half, then divide up bottom, right triangle equally along side.



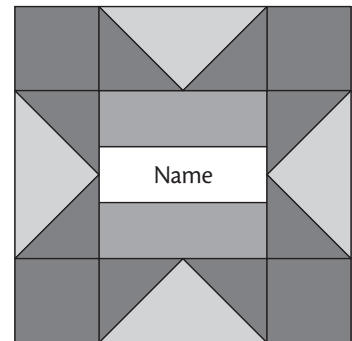
6. Shoofly Block: 9 squares with corner squares divided into triangles. Measure along the sides of the square to make an equal "tic-tac-toe" board.



7. Sawtooth Star: 4 small 1½ inch squares in the corners, with a square in the center and then 8 small surrounding triangles and 4 larger surrounding triangles.



8. Variable Star: 4 small 1½ inch squares in the corners, with a square in the center (made up of a smaller square and 4 triangles) and then 8 small surrounding triangles and 4 larger surrounding triangles.



9. Album Block: 4 small 1½ inch squares in the corners, with a square in the center (divided into 3 equal rectangles) and then 8 small surrounding triangles and 4 larger surrounding triangles.
